

## **Cost Recovery Policy**

## I. Purpose

This policy outlines the fees for non-government entities requesting data access to the New Jersey Statewide Data System (NJSDS). As noted in the Data Use and Access Policy, the system may charge requestors a fee to develop and process data. This policy ensures that the data is accessible to eligible parties while also supporting the financial sustainability of the system by implementing a fee structure.

## II. Fee Structure

Access Type	Cost	Breakdown
Aggregate-Level	\$600+	<ul> <li>\$500 for computing costs</li> <li>\$100 per hour of researcher time to develop</li> </ul>
Individual-Level	\$12,000	<ul> <li>\$10,000 setup fee for the Administrative Data Research Facility (ADRF), which serves as the secure workspace</li> <li>\$2,000 user support fee (20 hours of technical assistance from Heldrich Center staff)</li> <li>\$100 per additional hour of researcher time beyond 20 hour setup</li> </ul>

## III. Fee Structure by Requestor Type

Requestors may include a <u>fee exemption request</u> with their application. Fees may be waived for current students who meet the access eligibility criteria, state agency staff, or staff of related non-governmental entities such as local school districts, colleges, or workforce development boards.

For-profit and non-governmental organizations are subject to the fees as listed above.
